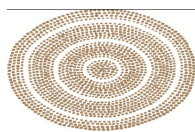

Mexico to be or Mexico not to be, shame on us can you see?



We would like to bring you follow up on the story that was featured in two issues of our newsletter in regards to our journey to Mexico. We were invited by Charity Coalition, DIF State Department, Office of First Lady of Mexico and Ministry of Culture to come back to Mexico and support the auction with exhibition of Danielle's artwork. During exhibition

we had scheduled visiting regions of La Paz with wife of Governor and meet with people and talk about our Indigenous Australian culture.

On schedule we had also communication with local Town Hall of La Paz, which expressed kind intent to connect our two cities as sister cities and we prepared several events, that would help our commercial and cultural community to address market in La Paz and also how we could support awareness about our two cultures via small two day festival each year.

We are very sad to announce, that we will be not able to travel to Mexico and we answered "No" on the invitation as we did not collect finances needed to

make the journey, although we addressed over 200 corporate potential partners.

Such sadness is for us not because we would not be able to travel to Mexico in November, but because such honor should be followed and as such we are left with shame, that is hidden in the failure to secure finances to be able to travel and represent our culture.

We do hope that all those who were supporters of our endeavors in Mexico will understand the reasons why we not able to travel, because our personal finances are not allowing us to do so and that all good people that were monitoring our journey will be happy to know, that we received invitation from Ministry of Culture of Mexico, which is asking us to build Indigenous Australian representation for 6th International festival of La Paz.

Grafton Solo Exhibition for Danielle as winner of the Grafton Art Prize 2009

As winner of the Grafton Art Prize in 2009, Danielle will open her solo exhibition in Grafton Regional Gallery on 26th October 2011.

We can't wait to show Danielle's new artwork and see some great friends and make new friends.

Exhibition will last for two

months and we hope that it will attract some crowd as Danielle would like to share her work and she is hoping that people would be able to find their own love in the artworks. Furthermore, the exhibition and every chance that Danielle has to showcase her art is also connection to her ancestry and

with every painting that is generated she tribute to her people and other Indigenous Australians and Indigenous people around the world.

We are very happy to announce that we connected with Club Coffs and its CEO and we are preparing set of art workshops for children, adults and disadvantaged community, which will be held in the Club. Target of this art workshops by Danielle is not only to attract people in the great surroundings of the Coffs Club, but also to support our local community as the workshops for the disadvantaged community will be free of charge as agreed upon by Danielle Burford

and Mr. Mover.

This is very good news, because the Club did not only generated new opportunity in the arts sector for many local artists, but also gives a sign about intention of supporting community and all that with genuine interest of the management in the advancement of the local community.

Club Coffs and Danielle do not only work on the matter of the art workshops, but they also did agree that Club Coffs will be one of three establishments hosting First Global Festival of Native Arts and Culture in 2012 in Coffs Harbour. Danielle as president of the festival and CEO of the Coffs Club Mr. Mover agreed that Club will be able to bring Indigenous Mini festival of short movies, which will be opened by movie "Ten Canoes" and close by "The Tracker", both from great production of director Mr. De Heer, but Club will also

host two musical performances and little photographic exhibition. Although negotiations are still on the way and we are still talking with our Honorable Elders in Coffs Harbour about the production possibilities, we are happy that Club Coffs is one of the Genuine local subjects, which are looking forward to enrich local cultural life and support Arts and Culture of Indigenous Australia as well as other cultures of many that we can find in diverse Australian community.

We are very happy and honored with such connection and we do sincerely thank Club Coffs and Mr. Mover and Board of Directors for their intentions and support.

His contribution to Indigenous and non—Indigenous world that is pure sharing of love and Culture is amazing and we strongly recommend-

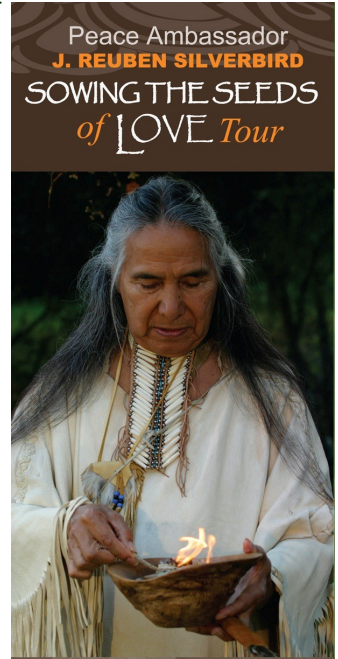
ing all of you to come and visit performance of Reuben.

Painting is full of emotions and the legacy which this artwork holds is future for our children that lies within respecting our Honorable Elders and the wisdom with

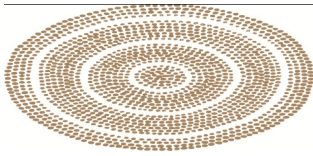
knowledge they are holding and passing to us.
